## **CAR PARKING**

There is ample parking for minibuses and cars on site, please make sure you enter your registration details at the main reception to avoid any penalty charges

Additional parking for parents and supporters is free for 4 hours and can be topped up for £2.00 at main reception.

## **CHANGING FACILITIES**

Changing rooms will be assigned on the day, please do not leave any valuables in there.

# ISA Tournament Rules and Regulations

## **PUSH BACK:**

Coin toss between captains will determine ends and push back.

## **MATCHES:**

- In2Hockey rules – ([Click here](#))
- 10 minutes one way
- 2-minute breaks between matches

## **CENTRAL TIMING:**

Morning and afternoon matches will be run using central timing, where a team is late:

- 1second – 59 seconds late = 1 goal conceded
- 1min – 2min 59secs late = 2 goals conceded
- 3+mins = match forfeited 3-0 (unless agreed upon between both team's coaches)

This will be decided by the tournament referee (ISA Sport). If a team is late, each coach must agree to what rule is being applied before the match begins (i.e. how late the team was). It is important to remember that this event is for the enjoyment of the participants so please refrain from challenging decisions.

In the event of an injury, the player's safety will be prioritised. If the player cannot be moved safely (discretion of Medical) and the match ends, the score at the time of the injury will be taken.

## **PLAYING COLOURS AND MATCH BALL:**

Team named first must change or wear different coloured bibs in



the event of a clash. Team named second provides ball.

### **SUBSTITUTIONS:**

Any player substituted during a match will become a substitute and may, in turn, replace another player at any time (rolling subs). The official must be notified before the substitution is made.

### **GROUP MATCHES:**

In group matches (AM / PM)

- 5 points will be awarded for a win,
- 2 points for a score draw and
- 1 point for a goalless draw.

In the event of two or more schools being level on points, teams will be separated as followed:

Head-to-head record > Goal difference > Goals scored > Goals conceded > Toss of a coin

### **AFTERNOON KNOCKOUT MATCHES:**

Each team will qualify for a set of afternoon round robin matches, regardless of where they finish in the group. Following the conclusion of the groups if standings are tied teams will be separated as above. In the 3/4 Playoff and Final if a team is tied there will be 3 penalty shuffles (sudden death as required).

Cup: 1<sup>st</sup> in Groups (Stadium Pitch 1)

Plate: 2<sup>nd</sup> in Groups (Stadium Pitch 2)

Bowl: 3<sup>rd</sup> in Groups (Outside Pitch 1)

Trophy: 4<sup>th</sup> in Groups (Outside Pitch 2)

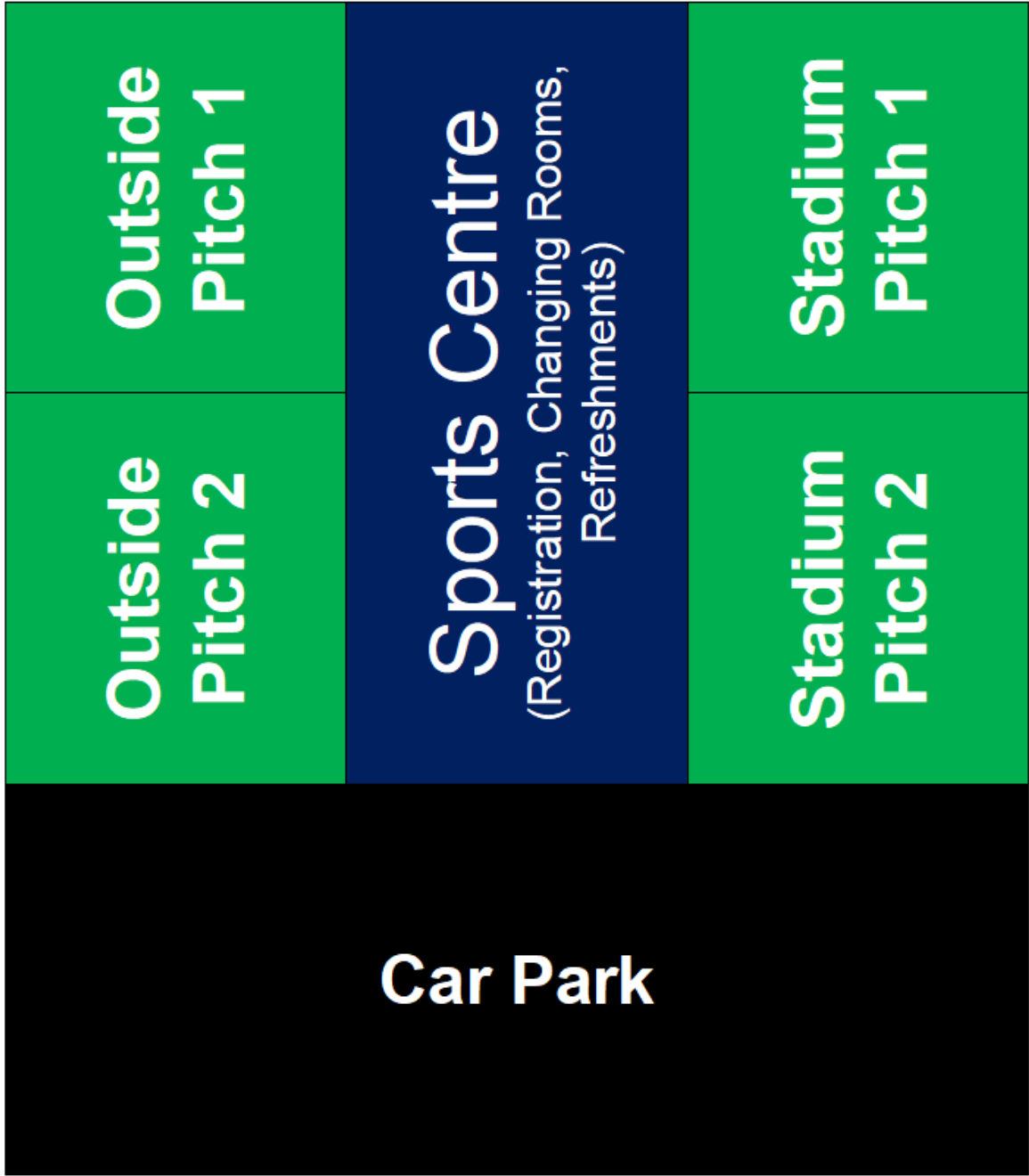
