Playing Time / Overtime

- Games will consist of one 15-minute running clock period
- Overtime will start with a jump ball and will be held under sudden death rules (first one to score wins)
- The clock will be stopped as per regular basketball rules the last minute (If game is within 5 points) and overtime period

General Provisions

- Players fouled in the act of shooting will shoot 1 free-throw for 2 points
- If a player scores and is fouled, he will be given an additional point for his basket (3 points for a 2 pointer & 4 points for a 3 pointer)
- A player will foul out of the game with 4 personal fouls
- The fifth and any subsequent defensive team foul will result in the opposing team to shoot 1 free throw for 2 points
- Team fouls will be carried over into overtime
- Any technical foul will result in 1 point for the opposing team and the play will continue from where the play stopped
- Two technical fouls in one game from one player will result in their disqualification from the game
- Subs need to check in with the table officials and will be brought in by referee at next dead ball opportunity
- The first team listed on each fixture will use bench A and the team listed second will use bench B

The tournament will be a round robin style tournament of play. Each team will play be determined by registrations. A detailed tournament programme will be sent out 1 month before the event. The four teams with the best overall record will advance to the semi-finals. If there are any teams with the same record points difference will be the deciding factor on who advances. The finals will then be played between the two winning semi-finalists.
